Treasurer update:

- 1. Scholarships were provided at the end of the year as budgeted and presented at the Band Awards Pot Luck on June 6 at 6:30. Scholarships presented as follows based on application and essay submissions judged by the band director and the Band Patrons executive board:
 - a. Summer Camps: Gabriel Rivera Martinez- \$500 (National Jazz workshop-George Mason) Holden Anderson- \$750 (Drum Major Academy at UMass)
 - b. Senior Scholarships: Malcolm Taylor- \$500 (attending Towson in fall 2017) Aidan Martin- \$500 (attending Christopher Newport in fall 2017)
 - c. Assistant drum major \$500 set aside for participant to be named by the Director.
- 2. We are starting the year with a reserve of \$2,000 as planned.

- 1. All teachers from last year are returning this year providing music, marching and guard instruction for students. There will be a new Brass instructor from the Army Old Guard Band (Rusty Smith).
